The example will be in a comfortable range for each voice part.

It will be in a major key, in 4/4 time. It will begin and end on the tonic.

It will consist of scalar motion and triadic leaps. Rhythm may include whole, half, quarter, and eighth notes, as well as dotted quarter/eighth combinations.
